



A WELCOME

Dear Parent/Carer/Player

On behalf of Eagles Badminton Club I would like to welcome you or your child to the club and give you some details about the club and how we run.

Eagles provides opportunities for young people between the ages of 7 and 18 to receive coaching, match play and practice at each of the sessions. Additionally, players will be given the opportunity to take part in local competitions and matches. We also run a session for adults giving them an opportunity to play local league badminton. All of our coaches have been DBS checked and have gained Badminton England recognised coaching qualifications. Our senior coaches are members of the Badminton England coaching register.

We welcome parents to all competitions and are keen to try and involve parents in the club and value your support. If you would like to be involved in any way, however small please speak to any of the club officials.

Coaching sessions take place at Royal Liberty School in Gidea Park. We offer sessions for primary age children (5 to 10yrs) on Mondays and Wednesdays between 6pm and 7pm. Our sessions for secondary age children (11 to 16/18yrs) are on Mondays between 7pm and 8.30pm, Tuesdays between 6pm and 8pm, Wednesdays between 7pm and 9pm and on Thursdays between 6pm and 8pm. We have adult sessions on Mondays between 8.30pm and 10.30pm, and on Tuesdays between 8 and 10pm. Both our adult sessions have coaches in attendance. Sessions run all year round, with the exception of Bank Holidays and Christmas.

Arrangements should be made for your child to travel to and from coaching sessions and matches/competitions. We would appreciate it if children can arrive promptly and are collected promptly at the end of each session, if they are not making their own way home. If you are going to be late, please inform the Head Coach (07885 063542).

An optional club shirt is available and should be worn with black shorts/skirts in matches and tournaments. The tops are available from Amanda at a cost of £23 which includes printing.

We would be grateful if you could keep us up to date with your information eg should contact details, medical conditions alter then please let us know. These must be as up to date as possible as we may need to contact you should your child feel unwell or have an injury during the session.

If you would like to talk to anyone at the club about this information or on any matter concerning the club then please do not hesitate to contact any club official. We thank you for your co-operation and look forward to meeting you at some time in the future.

SUBS AND FEES

Fees are payable for each session attended and are:

- Primary £30 a month
- Secondary (1.5 hours session) £33
- Secondary (2 hours session) £35
- Adult Monday (plastic shuttles) £24
- Adult Tuesday (feather shuttles) £26
- Special discount for both adult sessions £40

There is an additional, annual affiliation/membership fee of £10 (junior) and £20 (adult) which is paid on joining and every September thereafter.

This affiliation fee covers membership to the club as well as a standard Badminton England membership. Badminton England membership includes £10 million combined Public Liability Insurance when taking part in a recognised activity as well as many other benefits. If a member wishes to take part in Badminton England recognised tournaments, a Compete membership is required at an additional cost to the member and can be paid for by logging into your Badminton England account. Our monthly fees are calculated to take into account weeks that we are unable to use the hall and are averaged out over a 12 month period so regardless of the actual calendar weeks in each month the monthly fee will remain the same. We also take into account Bank Holidays and possible closures for bad weather.

Payment of monthly subs and the annual membership fee are by Direct Debit. Monthly subs are due on the 1st of each month. Our Membership Subscriptions and Fees Policy can be found in full on the club website.

CLOSURES AND CHANGE OF VENUE

Our sessions run all year round, with the exception of Bank Holidays and Christmas where we have no sessions during the school Christmas break. Sessions are ordinarily held in the New Hall at Royal Liberty School in Gidea Park, however Royal Liberty use this hall during exam periods at which time our sessions will move to the Old Hall. You will always be informed in advance when sessions will move and full directions and a map of the school indicating both halls is available on the club website.

Should we need to cancel a session at short notice, for example due to bad weather or other circumstances not under our control, we will always send out an SMS message to those affected. Please keep us up to date regarding any change in mobile phone numbers so that you do not miss any important messages.





PARENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

For the parents/carers of junior members, it is YOUR responsibility to know where your child is at all times and to ensure that they arrive at and depart from sessions safely. Parents/carers are welcome to stay and watch at any session, and we recommend that parents of primary age children stay during the session. Where Eagles Badminton Club assume a legal or moral duty of care we would take the following measures to ensure a reasonable standard of care:

- We will take a register at the beginning of every session
- We will maintain appropriate supervision levels, with at least two coaches in every session
- We will provide coaches at every session with emergency contact numbers and information on pertinent medical conditions
- We will ensure that first aid provision is available at the venue (See our Access to First Aid Statement)
- We will ensure that those responsible for the supervision of children and young people have been subject to appropriate recruitment and selection processes

Please be aware that toilet facilities at Royal Liberty School are in a shared or communal space and coaches cannot accompany children to or from the toilet facilities during a session. Children using the toilet facilities unsupervised are expected to return to the session immediately when they are finished and should speak to their coach if they have seen or heard anything that has worried them.

Our membership fee includes a standard Badminton England membership, which includes player insurance, the ability to enter Badminton England tournaments, support and exclusive discounts and opportunities.
